



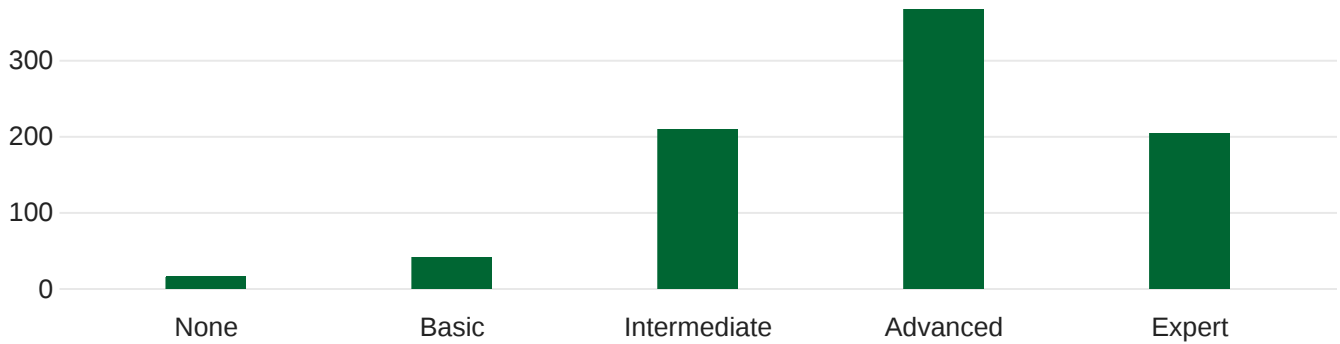

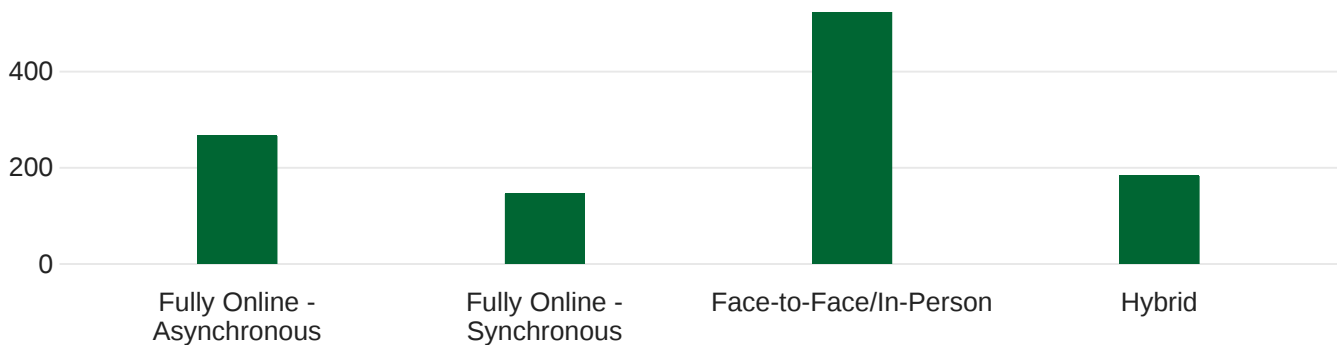

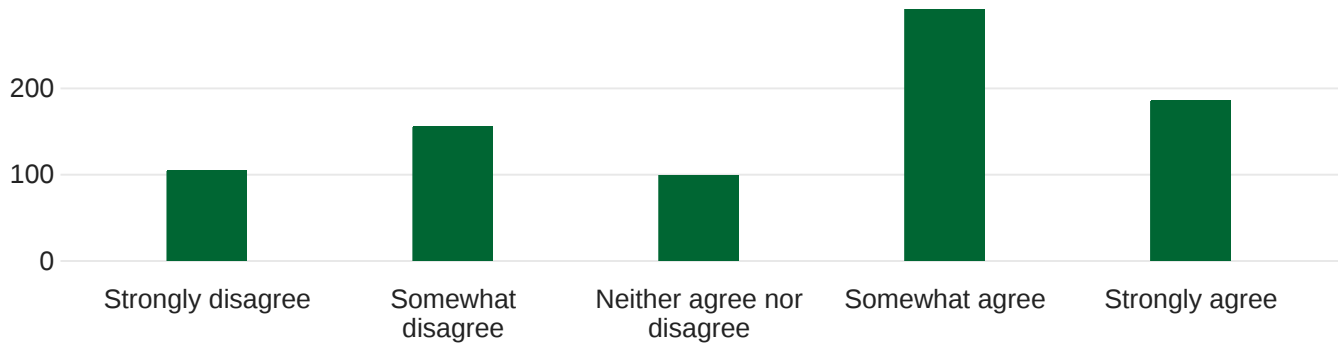
Rate your level of Blackboard knowledge.



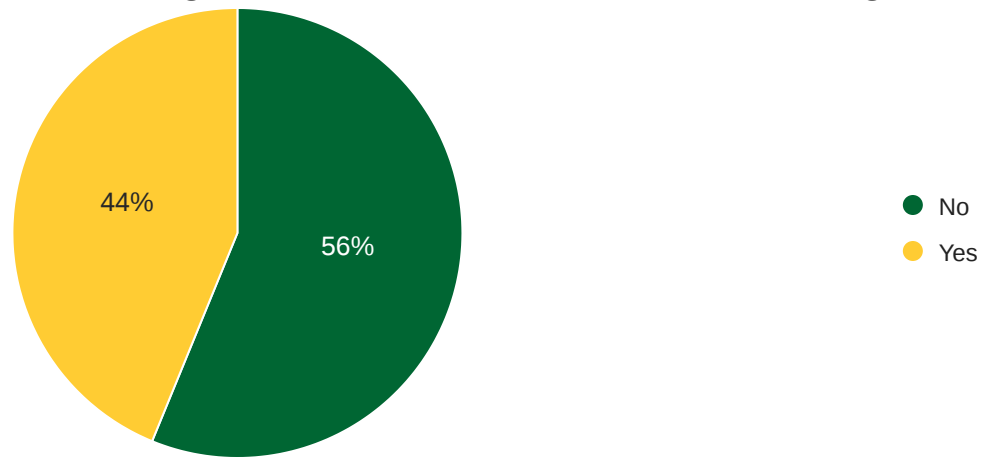

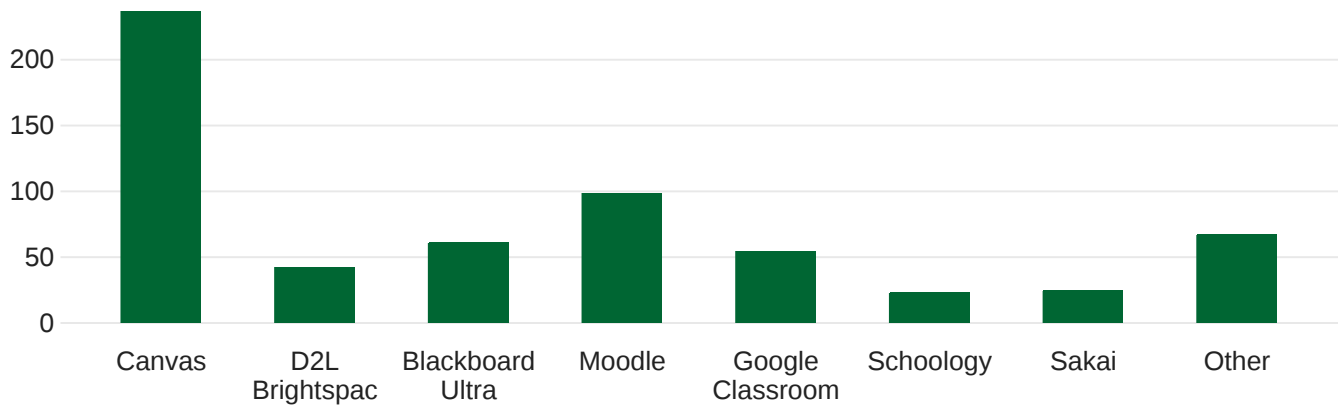
